For Anthroposophic Arts Therapies, Marianne Altmaier was appointed as the first coordinator in 1995 by Dr. Michaela Glöckler, then head of the Medical Section. She established authoritative structures and led the work for 6 years. Dagmar Brauer continued the work from 2001 to 2008 and then handed over to Kirstin Kaiser.

She led ICAAT until 2020 and during her time appointed co-coordinators for painting/sculpturing, music/singing, and conference preparation. In 2020, **Laura Piffaretti** took over the ICAAT leadership at the request of Kirstin Kaiser and through the appointment of section leaders Dr. Matthias Girke and Georg Soldner. Today, Karin Michael, Adam Blanning and Marion Debus are there for us in the section leadership.

- Quality assurance and competence development of arts therapies training and study courses (manuals in DE, EN and ES)
- Accreditation of training and further trainings

The iARTe was founded in 1996 as the European Academy (EA) of seven training and higher education programs and became to the iARTe in January 2020.

In January 2024 the iARTe counted the following members:

- -> 15 cooperating members




